1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Forty to Fifty percent of all students in Tustin Unified School District live in poverty. Many of these students meet the requirements to attend universities; however they struggle to pay tuition, room and board, books and supplies, and fees. These scholarships allow students to attend college who would be otherwise unable to attend. Scholarships will be distributed to all four high schools in the Tustin Unified School District.

Currently we are conducting interviews at Beckman High School, Foothill High School, Tustin High School and Hillview High School in the Tustin Unified School District.

Interviews were completed at Foothill High on May 17, 2016 8:30 am and Beckman High School on May, 17, 2016 8:30am

Interview were completed at Hillview High School on May 11, 2016 at 8:45am and were completed at Tustin High School on May 6, 2016 at 8:30am and have been completed.

Winners were notified by chairperson and family and winners were invited to lunch for scholarship presentations at June Rotary lunch meeting before graduation.

A total of approximately 18 Rotarians are involved throughout the process.


