Together with the Interact Club, Rotary Club of Laguna Beach will prepare Thanksgiving Care Packages to approximately 100 underprivileged familes, identified confidentially by the Boys & Girls Club of Laguna Beach. The food items for the Care Packages will be purchased at a discounted rate from Smart & Final. Each Care Package will also include a small gift certificate to Pavillions grocery store, to ensure that each receipient can buy fresh and healthy food that he or she knows his or her family will enjoy and appreciate. The gift certificates will be provided in lieu of perishable turkeys to ensure that each family can select a fresh meal that the family is sure to enjoy, instead of a turkey that, in addition to being cumbersome for the recipients to carry home, may also go uneaten if the family does not enjoy cooking turkey at Thanksgiving. Please note that the gift certificates are not redeemable for cash, and cannot be used to purchase alcohol or tobacco products.
