Attachment 1

Describe the project.

Between July 2015 and October 1, 2015, members visited three local schools in Signal Hill, California: Jesse Nelson Academy, Middle School Grades 5 to 8; Signal Hill Elementary School, Grades K to 5, and Alvarado Elementary School, Grades K to 5, to determine the total number of students attending school in the Fall. There were an estimated 2100 students planning to start school in September. School personnel provided Rotary Club with a "wish list" of school supplies for the students based on classroom needs. The wish list was translated into a purchase list and items were individually priced and a bulk discount supplier of school supplies was located.

Members held a fund raising dinner in December 2014 to start funding the project, raising about \$2000. Members approached community businesses and obtained the donation of 435 backpacks from Costco, valued at over \$4,000. Rotary Members solicited donations from the Signal Hill Police Officers Association, Aleshire and Winder, the City Attorney, and local residents. Robert Long, the individual who started the donation project 14 years ago, committed \$8,500 to the project; a local student and young actor, Prophet Bolden, donated \$1,150.

A budget was submitted to the District to secure a \$1,800 grant. Supplies were purchased and volunteers were solicited to pack the supplies into back packs or plastic tote bags. A total of 2177 bags of school supplies were assembled in the Signal Hill Police Department Emergency Operation Room over a period of one week, members providing snacks for volunteers. Employees from EDCO provided a truck and containers to move the 2177 backpacks to the Schools. When school started in September, Club members, wearing Rotary Shirts, were invited to pass out the back packs.

The volunteer sign in sheets reflects almost 50 volunteers donated time assembling and delivering the backpacks. Almost every member of the Rotary Club of Signal Hill volunteered time or donated money to the project.

How many non-Rotarians benefitted from this project?

2,177 kits were delivered to three schools in Signal Hill.

Signal Hill has a total population just under 11,000 residents.

Percentage wise, approximately 20% of the population of the City benefitted from the project, or 1 in 5 residents.

Attachment 5.

What are the expected long-term community impacts of this project.

The school supply project was started around 2000 and run by Signal Hill Rotary Members Robert Long, through his financial donations, and Al Gerbino, through donation of his business space for assembly of the kits.

By August 2014, the Rotary Club of Signal Hill saw that the project had outgrown its space and needed more volunteers.

Club members proposed that the Club officially “adopt” the School Supply Kit Project as its “community service project” as set forth in the Rotary Bylaws.

The 2014 Christmas Dinner was a fund raiser to support the Club’s FIRST official Community Service Project. Robert Long committed to fund \$8,500, which was ½ of the cost of the prior year project serving only two schools. President Mendoza and Treasurer Swidrak agreed to guarantee that the Club would raise the balance of the \$8,500 needed for the projected budget.

Members Lauer and Churchill secured student counts and a supply list, and costed out the supplies needed for three schools. This was the first year Jesse Nelson Academy added 800 more students, so the project was increased by 33%. This necessitated securing donations of back packs and other funds and supplies.

As a result of the Club adopting the project, the entire community became involved. The Signal Hill Police Department offered its facility to the Club to deliver and assemble the kits.

Each kit contained Thank you and Donation Recognition Cards. Each Kit contained a Rotary Label so students and parents would know that Rotary was giving back to the community. The Police Department sent out a NIXEL notice to all residents in the city (see attached) giving the Club publicity for its efforts.

This was the first year that the Club made a major community service out reach. Its efforts were rewarded with almost 50 volunteers. The prior year had less than 10 volunteers. Publicity included: tote stickers, donor cards, police contribution cards, Nixle announcement, press releases, photos on the website and Facebook and Blog.

Community partnerships included: EDCO, Signal Hill Police, Signal Hill Police Officers Association, and the Nancy Long Fund.

The goal of the Club is to continue the project each year, securing more donations of goods from local businesses.

Dear Carol A Churchill, Volunteers from the Rotary Club of Signal Hill and local residents are packing over 2100 back to school supply bags at the Signal Hill Police Department. The program started 13 years ago with donations from Robert Long and Nancy Long, long time Signal Hill residents and past Rotary Presidents. This year, the Rotary Club of Signal Hill partnered with the Long Fund to donate over \$20,000 in school supplies with donations from Rotary District 5320, the Signal Hill Police Officers Association, Prophet Bolden, a child actor on ABC's Fresh Off the Boat, Costco, and Aleshire and Wynder, the City Attorney. 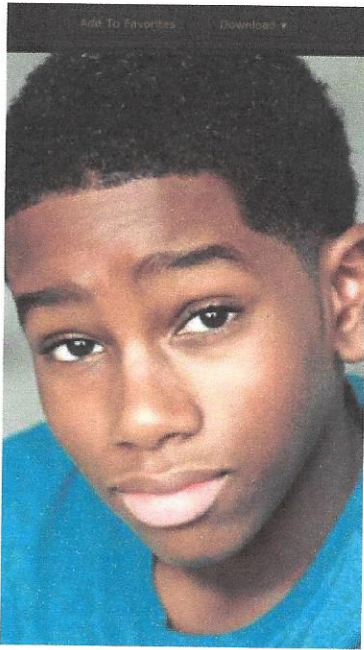

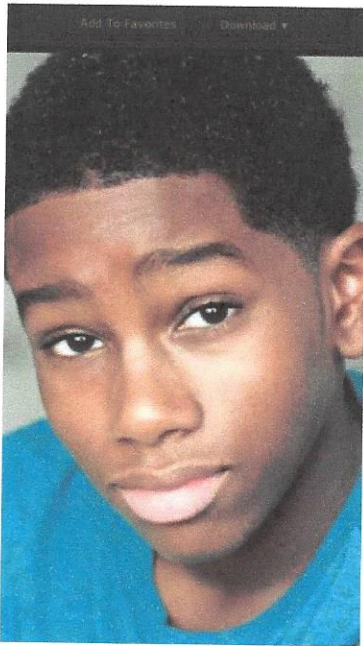

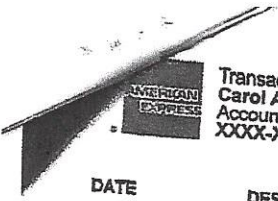
