1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?  
300 backpacks filled with basic school supplies were distributed to local elementary school children. The children who received the backpacks are from the lowest income families in our community. They were selected by school administrators who are aware that their families struggle to provide even the most basic needs. The backpacks were distributed in August 2015, at the beginning of the school year.

Two Rotarians researched the best pricing and ordered all school supplies.

During one regular meeting Rotarians assembled the backpacks and school supplies.

Rotarians personally delivered the backpacks to the local schools, including the President.

By providing children with basic items that are needed to help them be successful in school, the local community benefits. Children that are successful in school are more likely to make good choices, stay involved, and become responsible citizens. Benefits to the community include increased high school graduation rates, decrease in teen pregnancy, and decrease in illegal/gang activity.
