One of the Noteworthy Projects undertaken by the Rotary which catapulted Rotary to the International forefront is **POLIO PLUS PROGRAM**:

The most notable current global project, **Polio Plus**, is contributing to the global eradication of polio. Since beginning the project in 1985, Rotarians have contributed over US\$600 million and tens of thousands of volunteer-hours, leading to the inoculation of more than two billion of the world's children. Inspired by Rotary's commitment, the World Health Organization (WHO) passed a resolution in 1988 to eradicate polio by 2000. Now in partnership with WHO, UNICEF and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Rotary is recognized by the United Nations as the key private partner in the eradication effort.

Therefore, we must refine our strategies to reach these children and include them in our services. Reaching every community is an approach that strives at inclusion of all communities, especially the marginalized children, ensuring resources and services are available and monitoring is in place.

Rotary's commitment to "Service Above Self" has been channeled through the four Avenues of Service, which form the foundation of club activity. And, as signified by the motto "Service Above Self", Rotary's main objective is service — in the community, in the workplace, and throughout the world.

The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster:

First. The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service.

Second. High ethical standards in business and professions, the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations, and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society.

Third. The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life.

Fourth. The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

Rotary Club of New Delhi was formed in year 2005 and has since done several projects in the last 11 years. Some of the key notable ones are:

1. Supporting **Cancer Foundation** and Institute Rotary Cancer Hospital at All India Institute of Medical Sciences
2. Supporting the **Rotary Blood Bank** in Delhi and Noida
3. Supporting **Rotary Organ Donation**
4. Supporting **Polio Plus** for Polio Eradication from India and the World
5. **TEACH India** program to remove illiteracy at various Municipal Schools by supporting Handwash Stations and Toilets for girls and boys in Municipal and EWS schools plus **Health Checkup Programs** in schools and creating a free dental center
6. **Swachh Bharat** drive for cleanliness
7. **Tree Plantation** drives to improve environment
8. Supporting the **Girl Child Education** and **Mahila Ashram**
9. Supporting **NIIT Yuva Jyoti Program** for vocational training for youth
10. Supporting **Singer Sewing** centers for vocational training for girls and women to become self-reliant
11. Improvement in villages for water, sanitation and quality of education through **Rotary Community Corps**

To further our cause, RCND is embarking on a 3 years plan to involve in projects which would be sustainable & help in impacting a large audience needing support and assistance by becoming an independent part of the society and contribute towards their own and the country's growth.

MAIN PROJECTS FOR THE YEAR 2016-19

The club undertakes humanitarian projects to serve the society. During the years 2016-19 the club is planning to undertake projects on:

1. "Hole In The Wall" Learning Stations
2. "Evaluate The Health" for Children
3. "Water Life India" Drinking Program
4. Contribution towards **Construction & Awareness of Individual Toilets**

₹ 71Lacs "HOLE IN THE WALL" Learning Stations

Install HiWel "Hole in the Wall Computer" with built in software to enhance the education for the children at 50 Municipal schools in collaboration with NIIT for a total value of ₹71 lacs to provide digital literacy for children in and around under privileged communities in New Delhi with the objective to Provide a play-way learning solution which will help them to become digitally literate and mainstream with "Digital India" initiative by the Government. We plan to implement the project in underserved communities in consultation with South Delhi Municipal Corporation (SMDC). SMDC will provide the municipal school premises located in these communities to install the facilities which can be used by not only the school children but also by the out of school children and community in the project area. It is expected to impact 1000-1500 children of age group 6-12 in each community.



₹ 32.18Lacs "EVALUATE THE HEALTH"



Evaluate the health of school children from low socio-economic background with regard to Vitamin D deficiency, thyroid disorders and growth velocity for 500 Children to be conducted in primary schools adopted by Rotary Club at the cost of ₹32.18 lacs for a period of 95 weeks. The study report and recommendations for nutrients and food supplements to EWS children will be given to the government as a result of this pilot to be implemented across the other states of India.

₹ 25Lacs "WATER LIFE INDIA"

Waterlife India community drinking water program. Proposal is to setup water treatment plants to WHO and ISO 10500 standards for potable drinking water. These can be setup in any community and ground water can be sources and treated and provided at very reasonable rates. It would cost about ₹25lacs to setup and operate one such plant for 10 years and treatment process takes care of Microbial, Nitrates, TDS, Arsenic, Fluoride, Hardening and any other. We have reached out to slum development board and SDMC to find 3 sites in other states region where we could have a pilot implemented. The project would cost ₹25 lacs at each site.



₹ 25Lacs "CONTRIBUTION TOWARDS CONSTRUCTION & AWARENESS OF INDIVIDUAL TOILETS"



Rotary New Delhi Service Foundation Society has tied up with Sulabh Sanitation Mission Foundation, a leading NGO and non-profit organization in sanitation, hygiene and other sectors in India, to successfully contributing in achieving the goal of "Swachh Bharat" by 2019 as envisioned by our Honorable Prime Minister and contribution to an "Open Defecation free India" by the Year 2019. One of the success stories of a similar project undertaken by Sulabh in association with 'Boeing India' for building 127 toilets in Village Korali, in the district of Mewat highlighting the activities undertaken and objectives achieved was evaluated and RCND propose to add another 65 toilets in the same area to help the whole village become **Open Defecation Free**.
