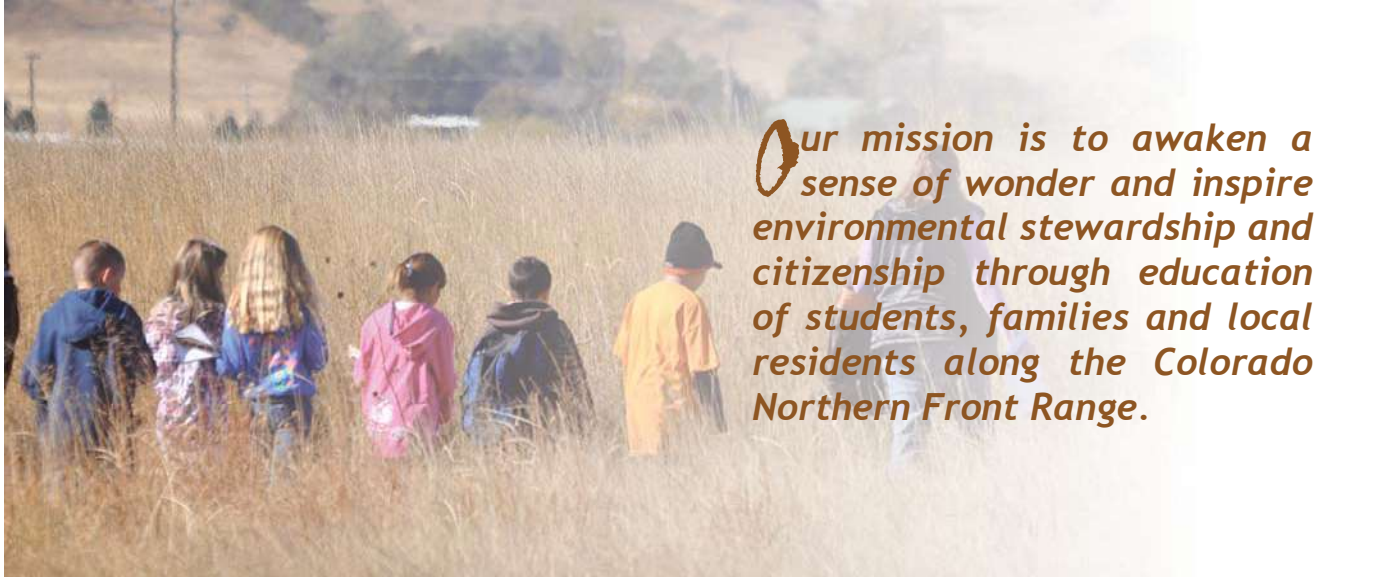

- Service learning

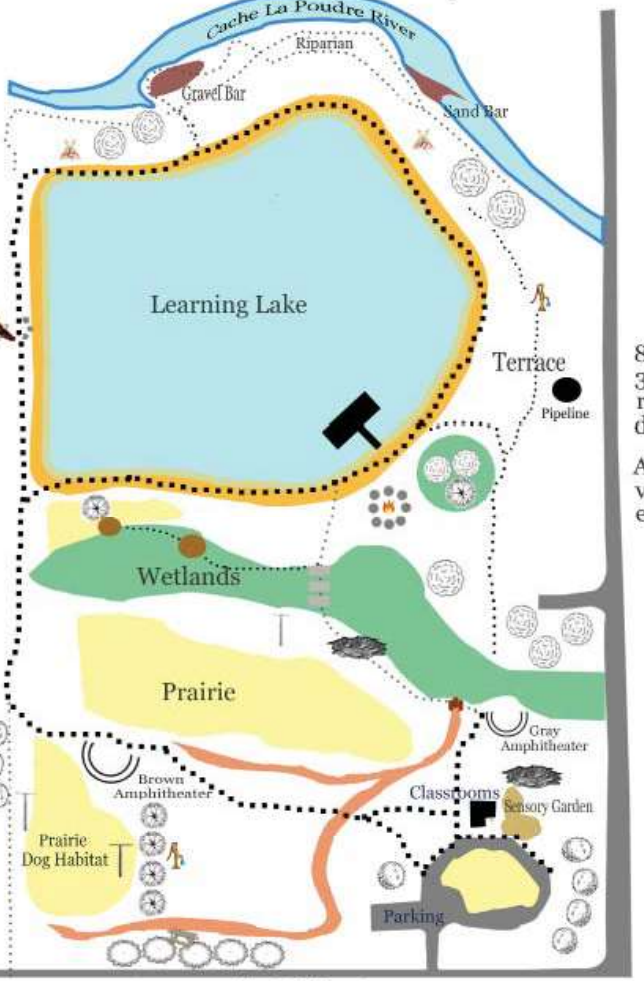

# Poudre Learning Center Conceptual Map



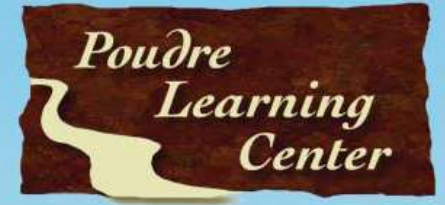
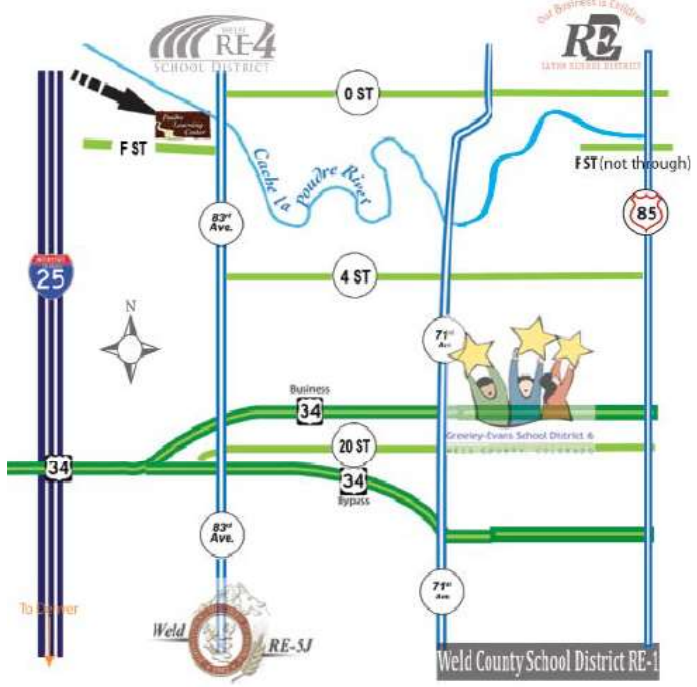
- Soil Pit
