MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN GANGA HOSPITAL AND MEDICAL CENTRE, COIMBATORE AND ROTARY CLUB OF COIMBATORE SAICITY, ON AID FOR SPINAL TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION, FOR A GLOBAL GRANT

BACKGROUND:

Ganga Hospital and medical centre in Coimbatore, is one of the renowned multi specialty hospitals in Coimbatore and are pioneers in orthopedic surgeries/treatments. Their thrust is on introducing newer and latest techniques in various fields of Accident Surgery, Trauma and Spinal Surgery, the introduction of microsurgical procedures, Reconstruction of severely injured limbs, re-plantation of completely amputated parts, advanced skeletal fixation. Reconstructive system, Microsurgery system to establish the hospital as one of the premier institutions of the country. Starting with 786 in-patients and 2686 out patients in 1992, there was a steady growth to 4900 in-patients and 9000 out patients in 1999. Patients are referred not only from across the length and width of the country but also from the neighboring countries. The hospital is now firmly established as one of the premier tertiary referral centres in this part of the world.

They have recently established a Rehabilitation and Vocational centre to treat and rehabilitate spinal injury patients to enable them to improve their mobility and lead an independent dignified living.

Rotary club of Coimbatore Saicity in association with other RI international Districts have done many Matching Grants and Global grants for their signature projects, namely, **Gift of life**- a project aimed at saving the lives of children with heart ailments and **Saicity Aid for Spinal Treatment and Rehabilitation**- a project aimed at improving the mobility and giving a dignified independent living to patients with spinal injury thru treatment and rehabilitation.

MOU details:

Based on the camps conducted, out- patient screening at the hospital premises and patients referred by other hospitals, a list of patients with spinal injury for rehabilitation is prepared which is to be constantly updated by the hospital.

The list will be scrutinized by a team of doctors and Rotarians for the following
Criticality of the ailment- patients needing immediate attention will be given priority.
Family background and income proof so that only deserving poor patients are selected

The list will be short listed by the team with priorities on urgency, prognosis, criticality and other parameters if any.

A review committee consisting of Rotarians and hospital staff will have a meeting with the patient to ascertain their willingness for rehabilitation and also convey the proposed date for admission to the hospital for treatment.

On admission of the patient the hospital administration will complete the requisite formalities including the preparation of the Medical chart detailing the name/address/age/family background /income proof/type of treatment details along with patient's concurrence and the surgeon's remarks are recorded with a passport picture of the patient affixed. These details will form part of the discharge summary to be sent along with the bill for payment. The Rotarians of RC Saicity will also visit the hospital at regular intervals to review the progress of the patients undergoing treatment.

As soon as the treatment is over, the hospital will ensure the safe discharge of the patient. The hospital will ensure that the patient is in good health and will release the patient with a discharge certificate with details on patient's stay/data on surgery details and follow-up requirements and medicines to be taken if any. They will also be provided with suitable Orthotics based on the need.

At the time of discharge the Rotarians with review committee members will be on hand to ensure safe discharge and also to coordinate the follow up activities. The committee will ensure the parents have understood the follow-up treatment requirements and to report at the hospital if there are any contra effects on the patient, post-treatment

The hospital will submit the bills for payment to RC Saicity along with the photos, medical charts and discharge summary/certificates on a monthly basis for payment.

The beneficiaries will also have a chance to meet the doctors and discuss their health issues if any, when Rotary Saicity organizes the meet of all the beneficiaries to celebrate the milestones achieved, on a regular basis.
