

ACTION PLAN

Stage 1: Design and implementation of specialized **training programs** on **life skills** and **business plans**.

Stage 2: Formation of **groupings** according to common business areas (*food services, retail trade, food industry, aesthetic services and livestock*).

Stage 3: Provision of resources (equipment and supplies) for the start-up of the groups.

Stage 4: Monitoring and evaluation of the groups, and search for long-term strategic allies to ensure sustainable growth.


