- Started in 2010 , always '**FREE**' for needy patients
- Annual 1 camp – 1 week between Jan and March
- Approx 55/60 surgeries / camp
- 'Operation Smile' + NBC + Rotary Deonar
- Surgeons from various countries + local
- Brought the Equipment , consumables along
- Process oriented approach, documentations
- Hospital infrastructure was optimal

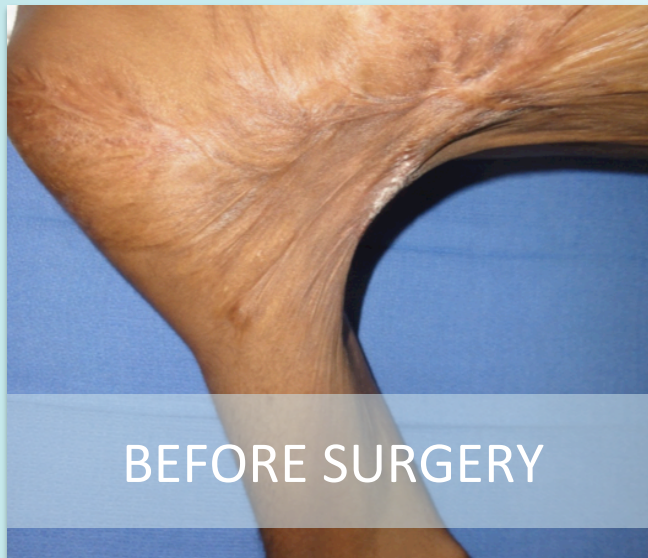

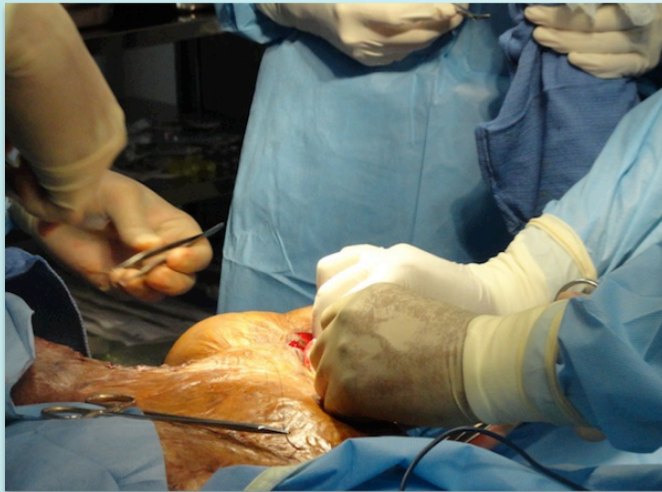

The Present

- This Year SMILE team unable to participate
- NBC and Rotary still decided to go ahead with the project
- Rotary Clubs invited to join Operation Restore



NBC Contribution

- Cost of Each Surgery is about Rs 80,000/-
- NBC is taking only expenses for medicines and consumables whereas all cost for treatment and hospitalization is underwritten
- This works out to be Rs 20,000/- per surgery
- Screening: It's a year long continuous process
 - On Every Tuesday and Friday
 - Between 1 to 3 pm at NBC

More surgeries per year

- About 200 Surgeries will be performed during the next two years
- Possibly, 8 Camps Per year, with 3 surgical days



More Clubs participation

- Operation Restore is aimed to be a District Project with participation of more and more clubs, this campaign can grow to a higher dimension
- Burn victims from different parts of the country can be reached. With Large number of clubs partnering, a much larger scale public awareness campaign will be taken up



Role of Clubs

- We require help in identifying burns victims and referring them to our Operation Restore team for screening.
- We require help to arrange Direct Sponsors or in kind e.g. consumables, medicines etc.
- We require Volunteers in the camp to add a human touch.



Awareness of Skin Donation

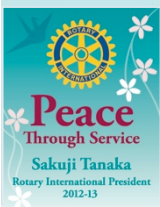
- Annually 01st -7th August is Skin Donation Awareness Week
