4. Understandings

- A. All parties affirm that Global Grant #GG1410860 is initiated, controlled, and managed by the Rotary clubs and/or districts involved in the project.
- B. Roatan RC and Arlinton, TX RC affirm that Aqua para el Pueblo is reputable and responsible and acts within all governing laws of the project country.
- C. All parties acknowledge that Global Grant GG1410860, if approved, will be awarded to Roatan RC and Arlinton, TX RC and not to Aqua para el Pueblo.
- D. All project funds will be in the custody of the partner Rotarians and will not be managed by Aqua para el Pueblo.
- E. Aqua para el Pueblo must abide by The Rotary Foundation grant terms and conditions.
- F. Aqua para el Pueblo and its involvement in this project may be subject to financial and operational review/audit by The Rotary Foundation.

5. Roatan RC shall:
- A. Promote the project within the club in Roatan and District 4250.
 - B. Develop a relationship with our cooperating organization, the mayor of the municipality where the project is being done, and the Health Dept of Gracias a Dios.
 - C. Travel to Gracias a Dios during the project to monitor and ensure progress.
 - D. Maintain communications with the international partner club.

6. Arlington, TX RC shall:

- A. Complete overall grant planning and negotiate contracts/pricing with suppliers/contractors.
- B. Be responsible for fiscal control of funds and dispersal to contractors/suppliers.
- C. File reports to RI as necessary and the Final Report and be responsible for the overall success of the grant.

7. Agua para el Pueblo shall:

- A. Provide labor and expertise for filter installation and villager training.
- B. Transport materials from port of entry to the villages outlined by Rotarians.
- C. Stay on budget throughout the project.
- D. Provide organized financial data (receipts, expenses) and summary of all costs to ensure fiscal accountability.

8. Modification

Modifications within the scope of the instrument shall be made by mutual consent of the parties, by the issuance of a written modification, signed and dated by all parties, and approved by The Rotary Foundation prior to any changes being performed.

9. Conflict of Interest

Any real or perceived conflicts of interest must be disclosed to The Rotary Foundation, including any Rotarians serving as paid staff or board of directors for the cooperating organization.
