

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

ROTARY CLUB OF KONA SUNRISE, HAWAII USA (RCKS)

and

ROTARY CLUB PRISHTINA INTERNATIONAL, KOSOVO (RCPI)

and

**MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY
OF THE REPUBLIC OF KOSOVO (MEST)**

The Rotary Club of Kona Sunrise, the Rotary Club Prishtina International, Kosovo, and the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology of the Republic of Kosovo, are the parties to this Memorandum of Understanding. The three parties agree completely to the following:

Purpose and Scope

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is set forth the terms and conditions for providing drinking water to eleven (11) schools in the nation of Kosovo, and sanitation in three (3) schools in Kosovo. The proposed community locations are listed below:

Water: Turicec, Sllovi, Banulle, Gadime, Berishe, Busavete, Kllodernice, Gllgovc, Kraishte, Malishev, Shipashnice e Eperme

Sanitation: Drenoc, Perqeve, Sverke

Conditions and Arrangements

Parties have agreed that the Rotary Club Prishtina International ("RCPI"), in coordination with the Rotary Club of Kona Sunrise ("RCKS") will provide funding for the projects described in the Global Grant Application GG1523876, subject to a participatory contribution from each of the schools listed. The Ministry of Education, Science and Technology ("MEST") of the Republic of Kosovo agrees and pledges that each school shall provide funding in an amount equal to 25% of the cost of the whole project for each school (*prior to the commencement of the work*). RCPI in coordination with RCKS will provide the balance of funds required to ensure that the project is completed. RCPI will be responsible for selecting the company for implementation of all operational aspects and for following up until completion of the project. RCKS will raise the funds for the projects described in the Global Grant Application GG 1523876 that RCPI will be doing. The funds will include donations from individual Rotary clubs, Rotary District grants and/or matching funds, and a grant from The Rotary Foundation. In order to comply with the terms of the Global Grant from The Rotary Foundation, an accurate accounting of all funds spent, invoices and paid

receipts must be provided to RCKS and MEST not less than every three (3) months from RCPI. These progress reports shall include a description of work completed as of the date of the report, and include pictures whenever possible.

The school locations are expected sites. Individual MOUs will be required for each school. It is possible that some of the school locations may change if it is not possible for RCPI to reach agreement with one or more of the currently proposed schools. In that case, RCPI reserves the right to make these changes as they assess each situation. In the event RCPI finds the need to change one or more of the schools, RCPI agrees it will keep both the MEST and the Rotary Club of Kona Sunrise informed of any proposed changes in school locations, any adjustments to time schedules, and any changes in costs created by the proposed change.

Timing

The parties expect the projects identified in the Global Grant GG1523876 application to be initiated April 1, 2015 and to be completed by September 30, 2016.

Agreement

Effective as of the date of the last signature affixed hereto, the parties to this Memorandum of Understanding do hereby declare their agreement and pledge to abide by the terms of this agreement and the terms and conditions set forth in greater detail in the Global Grant Application GG 1523876.
