The foster children who attended the camp were wards of the state and it is the hope that this camp assisted these foster children by securing positive growth and attachments in their lives to help them overcome neglect, abuse and poverty.

It was difficult getting our members to volunteer at the High Plains Royal Family Kid's Camp since it was not in our community, but rather in our area instead.
