- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
Second and Third Grade students from Franklin, Hoover and Taft Schools in Santa Ana were bussed to Sea Base in Newport Beach Jan 19, 26 and Feb 2. The students, Teachers, parents and Rotarians attended classes on the water and pollution cycles and influence of human activity on the bay and marine life. The group then took a boat ride on Newport bay to the Back Bay museum where they examined specimens of marine organisms, saw live samples of shark, etc. Hands on Experience in all activities with all involved in the projects.
- How many Rotarians participated in the project? 8 Rotarians and 3 friends.
- What did they do? Please give at least two examples.
Rotarians assisted teachers and students in design of sailing boats. Others assisted with sifting mud samples to uncover marine living organism. Others assisted with microscope examination and identification
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 176 Students, 14 Teachers and Parents from 3 schools
- What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?
More than 90% of the students have never been to the bay area. Knowledge of the water cycle and life in the bay and its influence on our own wellbeing is invaluable. As evident from their notes it was a success that they will remember and appreciate. Knowing that all actions by humans may adversely affect marine life and nature then our own wellbeing is of prime importance
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Boy scouts Sea Base Facility in Newport Beach conducted all activities.


