Project Description:						

1. Briefly describe the project. What was or will be done and where did or will the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were or will be involved?

The original project was to purchase furniture and install clean cooking stoves in the schools where possible. The Rotary Club of Craig, the After Hours Rotary Club of Greeley and Greeley Centennial Rotary combined club funds to add a classroom to one of the schools (no grant money was involved). We were able to install the clean cooking stove with those funds. We subsequently learned that uniforms are required for the children to attend school many families could not afford to purchase them. Therefore, children were not permitted to attend without uniforms. We were able to purchase all the furniture and uniforms with funds from this project.

2. How many Rotarians participated in this project? (estimate if progress report) 2

Two people coordinated the purchase of the furniture and uniforms through a local contact in Honduras. The WCS Committee members were involved in reviewing the progress and control of the project.

3. What did or will they do? Please give at least two examples.

See above for the committee members' involvement. One of the Centennial Club members along with several teachers from Greeley were in Honduras in Summer of 2017 to do some maintenance work on the schools. One of the teachers from Dos Rios Elementary is a native of Honduras. Her father was our local Honduras contact on the project.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? (estimate if progress report)

There are about 150 children enrolled in these schools.

5. Who are the beneficiaries and what is or will be the expected long-term community impact of this project?

All the Honduras children enrolled in these schools are the beneficiaries of this project, as well as the teaching of sharing by the students and parents of the Greeley/Evans Dos Rios School. With the furniture purchase and new uniforms, these 150 Honduran children with now have regular admittance into school with sufficient work space in which to learn.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was their role?

The Dos Rios Elementary School in Evans, Colorado. They continue to send school supplies to the Honduras schools. There is another work trip planned for Summer 2018 to support the development of a vocational sewing center to make additional uniforms and make other clothing repairs for the sustainability of the current project. This planned trip for the vocational center is being coordinated through the SSKIDS foundation in Greeley, Colorado.
