

Amaro Tan School Summer Camp Project – 1Q2018 Quarterly Report

There are just a couple of months left in the school year at the Amaro Tan School, in Pogradec, Albania. During the school year, students at this special school for Roma and Balkan Egyptian children go to school to learn. They, and their families, also receive nutritious meals, vocational training, and an array of other social services their communities often struggle to access.

This August, thanks to sponsorship from Estes Park Rotary, Amaro Tan students will be able to attend summer camp at their school, continuing their education, eating regular, nutritious meals, and enjoying the chance to have fun being kids in a supportive, wholesome environment. Teachers at Amaro Tan will soon begin to plan this project, to be discussed in a report closer to the camp date.

No funds have been transferred or spent yet on this project, which will begin in the summer. The grant will be spent in summer, 2018, to support camp operations.

Nehemiah Gateway USA has partnered with the Estes Park High School National Honor Society on a fundraising event to support the Amaro Tan School, to be held April 21, 2018. In 2018-19, Nehemiah Gateway USA will develop a program and recruit Estes Park students to travel to Albania and help with the Amaro Tan summer camp in summer, 2019.
