1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Whittier Rotary sponsored instruction on dental hygiene for 1,000 students by dental professionals at two schools in the Whittier area: April at Mill Technology Academy for 450 students, and April 23 at Daniel Phelan Language Academy for 550 students. At the end of the multi-day instructions, Rotarians came to the schools and handed out individual dental kits for students to take home.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

At Mill on April 7, five club members participated, and at Phelan on April 23, six club members participated.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Rotary club members handed out dental kits to students as the students left class for the day.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

I think every student benefited, and members of the students' family probably benefited. So, at the low end 1,000 students benefited, and when family members are added, several thousand individuals benefited.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

The long-term benefit is healthier children. And, healthier children learn better and prevent strain on family benefits for dental problems that were ignored for too long.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

The Children's Dental Health Clinic from Long Beach provided the professionals that came to the schools, worked with the students and conducted the dental health screening. They also prepared the dental hygiene kits that we Rotarians gave to the students.
