Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done?

Initially a leadership academy was projected to occur in early April, but the group responsible to provide the project backed out. Rotary requested proposals from faculty and community members on how to proceed. A plan to provide five workstations in two different school locations and materials for a leadership activity for another group of students at a horse therapy facility was decided. There was a dire need for this equipment in all of the locations and the amount of students and faculty that would benefit from the purchases was significant. Additionally, the books purchased for a leadership activity for middle school students with one of our own Rotarians as the facilitator would have our Rotary working with students in this project from 4 to 18.

Who were the beneficiaries?

Payson Christian School, Payson Center for Success Robotics, 18 middle school students

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

128 students 4-18. 16 teachers and 3 volunteers

5. What were the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Continued education at Payson Christian School in the arts, computer lab and preschool kindergarten areas, Added assistance in the Payson Center for Success Robotics program to move it further up the ladder in robot development, and touching 18 middle school students with leadership skills to take into their adult life with the help of Dueker Ranch and its horses.
