We expect it to contribute to their education as well as their sense of value (self-worth). We also anticipate a broader view of the world through learning about other countries.

The Dictionary Project would not have been possible without the enthusiastic participation of the four area schools. They provided space, supplied teachers, prioritized time in the school day for the program, and embraced our mission and objectives.
