- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

  The long-term community impact of the project is to enable students seeking an advance degree to concentrate on their field of study and not worry about how they will repay college debt when finished. By reducing financial concerns, the student will be able to focus more on studying, learning and retaining the knowledge he/she is exposed to. The scholarship award aids in selecting how to spend free time in order to maximize the college experience through service-learning, volunteer activities and possibly internships.
- 6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?
  We did not involve a cooperating organization for the scholarship awards.
- 7. How did you share the news of your project?
  Each of the schools printed the names and amount of the awards in the scholarship program booklet. The scholarship recipients attended a Rotary meeting where they were presented with the checks made payable to the individual student.
