   Bring art and peace instruction into the classrooms. The classrooms selected are in 80% or more Hot Lunch
  Program schools in Chicago. There were four partner clubs involved with the Smart Art and Peace Initiative.

- 7. How did you share the news of your project? Cliff Harstad addressed other Rotary Club and introduced the project at RI functions, the Smart Art and Peace Initiative has a place on our CFD website, CFD had a manned table at the club pride night at the District Conference.
