We conducted a one-day free seminar working with Mid Plains Community College to provide the training. There were 16 in attendance representing 15 different county-wide organizations. The response was nice. The area leaders in attendance were pleased with the training with several later being successful in the grants with which they applied.

Also – we had three club members in attendance (and have since gained two of the other attendees) who are now not as nervous about applying for grants not only through Rotary but through other agencies such as state Foundations.
