Congratulations! The Rotary District 5400 Scholarship Committee has completed their review of the scholarship applicants and has unanimously chosen you as the recipient of the District's scholarship! We are all very excited for you and we were extremely impressed with both your academic and personal commitment to excellence. You represent all that Rotary stands for and we are proud to support you in your education.

You will be eligible to receive this award for four (4) years if you present documentation that you are meeting the guidelines of the award. The award will be mailed to you in \$500 per semester installments beginning in October of 2018 and then again in January of 2019. - Applicants should be in pursuit of a 4 year degree (bachelor level degree)
