- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
This is the fifth year that the Whittier Sunrise Rotary Club as supported the Children's Concerts of the Rio Hondo Symphony, now known as the Whittier Regional Symphony. The concerts are for 4th and 5th grade students from Whittier area schools and are designed to introduce the students to symphony instruments and classical music a focus which the schools are not able to adequately support. Again this year, two concerts were held, on January 16 and 17.
- How many Rotarians participated in the project?
Six Whittier Sunrise Rotarians participated over the two days of the concerts.
- What did they do? Please give at least two examples.
Club members assist with the unloading and reloading of the buses that bring the students from their schools to the high school auditorium where the concerts are held. As a result of our continuing support of the Children's Concerts, our club has developed a close relationship with the symphony association. We now regularly organize the handicapped parking and assist the unloading of vans from several senior residencies at the four regular free concerts of the association. Students from our Interact Club at California High also assist us.
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?
2,098 students attended the concerts over the two days.
- What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?
We believe this is a meaningful contribution to the students' education. We also receive recognition as our contribution is acknowledged at one of the regular concerts.
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?
The Whittier Regional Symphony Association is the organizer of the concerts. Our contribution is directed to the transportation costs.
