Eggs and/or dairy products were purchased locally and distributed at the Donnelly Food Pantry for low-income members in the area. The Donnelly Food Pantry is located at 370 Main St., Donnelly, ID 83615 and open every Thursday from 4 – 6pm. Food boxes, including the eggs/dairy provided by the Rotary grant funds were distributed on a weekly basis. A flyer was handed out on a bi-weekly basis with the nutritional value of eggs/milk, and ideas on how to include eggs/milk in your diet, along with recipe cards made by Rotarians.

The Rotary logo was included on the printed pieces and a placard was hung over the dairy refrigerator letting clients know the eggs and dairy products were sponsored by the McCall Payette Lake Rotary Club.

4. In one brief sentence: who were the beneficiaries of the grant activities and how many of them were there?
The beneficiaries were low-income members of the Donnelly community. There were approximately 750+ individuals served on a monthly basis.

15 Rotarians participated in the project. They helped distribute the food boxes, made recipe cards to include in the food boxes and help keep the Donnelly Pantry organized.
