Long term value is immense in that each video was designed for both virtual and in-classroom instruction and can be used multiple times.

All the Arts Foundation was our collaborative partner to oversee the project to ensure compatibility with virtual and classroom formats as well as grade-level appropriateness of each lesson. They recruited and contracted with faculty and oversaw the work.
