- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? Built a home in less than one day on May 7, 2022 with the Corazon organization for the López López family in the Valle de las Palmas community located in Tecate, Mexico. Five people are the beneficiaries of the home, Pascuala and her four children (Rocio, Luis, Mateo, Martha).
- How many Rotarians participated in the project? A total of forty to fifty Rotarians and Rotaractors participated in the home build. Our club's contribution helped fund 9 Rotaractors from UC Irvine and Soka University to participate in this international project.
- What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Constructed a home with septic tank in that one day. Activities included framing, painting, roofing, use of power tools. There was an opportunity to interact with the local people and beneficiaries of the project.
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Five people in the López López family now have their own home because of this project. Also, the entire Corazon community as well.
- What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Be able to provide stable housing to a family and allow them to focus on other priorities such as the kids' education.
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? The cooperating organization was Corazon. The organization identifies the recipient family, provides a community for the families involved, finds a location for the home, and helps the family fulfill the criteria to be eligible for a home.
