Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project outcomes. What was done (in 100 words or less)? Save the Family is a non-profit organization that provides temporary housing and basic life skills training to approximately 600 - 700 families each year, the majority of which are single women with children. Consequently, there is a continuing need for basic household necessities e.g., sheets, towels, kitchen utensils, etc. Rotarians purchased these items from discount stores and assembled 60 "starter kits" for incoming families..

When (dates) and where (city, state and country) did project activities take place?

Project activities started in August 2021 and were completed in October. The activities took place in Fountain Hills, Arizona USA and surrounding towns.

Who were the beneficiaries? Recent homeless families (60) starting new lives at Save the Family, a non profit located in Mesa, Az.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Approximately 14 Rotarians participated.
3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Rotarians purchased an assortment of household items from a variety of discount stores and subsequently packed them in boxes for distribution. Included were: dinner ware, dish towels, pots and pans, small kitchen utensils, knives , dish rack , etc.
4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 60 homeless families.
5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Helping families become self sufficient members of the community.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Save the Family, a non profit in Mesa, AZ assisted by identifying the opportunity to assist incoming families and suggesting the specific needs for same when they are initially assigned to their temporary lodging unit.
