Following is in answer to your questions:

- 1) The receipt from Costco Westminster on 2/3/22 is a full receipt that is spaced to show the food carts vs basic needs for accounting purposes. If you total all of the items listed (minus, 29.74, the subtotal tax of 8.75%) you will get 556.95 (plus \$37.00. the full 8.75% tax on all of the taxable items); the total is \$593 95.
- 2) The gift cards were purchased to address families' need's that H.O.P.E. was not able to supply directly (i.e., baby items); this provides self-esteem for the recipient to be able to select just what they need such as baby clothing in a size that is not available in the H.O.P.E. pantry.
