Following is in answer to your questions:

1) The receipt from Costco Westminster on $2 / 3 / 22$ is a full receipt that is spaced to show the food carts vs basic needs for accounting purposes. If you total all of the items listed (minus, 29.74, the subtotal tax of $8.75 \%$ ) you will get 556.95 (plus $\$ 37.00$. the full $8.75 \%$ tax on all of the taxable items); the total is $\$ 593$ 95.
2) The gift cards were purchased to address families' need's that H.O.P.E. was not able to supply directly (i.e., baby items); this provides self-esteem for the recipient to be able to select just what they need such as baby clothing in a size that is not available in the H.O.P.E. pantry.
