- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
Summer Harvest is a nonprofit organization that supports underprivileged children and their families with food and other resources. The project consisted of providing Summer Harvest with the resources (\$2,000) necessary to purchase food and/or school supplies and then assisting them in preparing those school supplies for distribution. . .
- How many Rotarians participated in the project?
A total of 10 Rotarians and their spouses participated.
- What did they do? Please give at least two examples.
Community members, including Rotarians and their spouses, gathered at the Youth Center where we unloaded the school supplies, arranged them on tables and stuffed backpacks with about 2-dozen assorted school supplies. Those backpacks were then loaded into vehicles for transportation to the site where they were distributed to families.
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?
Approximately 800. (The backpacks and food were distributed to 200 families with approximately 4 members per family.)
- What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?
Long term impacts for a small project such as this are difficult to predict. Given that, in conjunction with other efforts in the community we feel certain that we have helped alleviate blocks that lead to success and financial independence.
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?
Aside from Summer Harvest, The Youth Center provided the space to organize the school supplies and pack the backpacks.
