## Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Rotary Club of FW South provided funds for the FWISD to purchase 25 modular student desks and 25 chairs to make the best possible use of space in the library of Richard J. Wilson Elementary School. Approximately 95% of the students who attend this Title One school are economically disadvantaged. This school year, there was an influx of students to the student body following the closure of another FWISD elementary school. Computer labs had to be converted to classrooms to accommodate the additional students. Maximizing space became critical.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 8 Rotarians

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Sustained ongoing communication with the school administration and established priorities for this project and additional projects throughout the school year; reviewed the school's request for library furniture, completed the district grant application and requested additional funding from the club's own foundation; carried out other projects this school year including stocking the teacher break room, hosting five academic achievement recognition events, distributing dictionaries to all third graders, hosting an end of the school year bike give away and hosting a teacher appreciation.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

The library is used for a multitude of classroom and extra-curricular activities, as stated on the grant request. The new furnishings maximize the use of the space, offering multiple configurations and flexibility and will be a long-term enhancement to the school.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Rotary Club of FW South worked with the leadership of Richard J. Wilson Elementary on the library project and other school projects throughout the school year.
