## Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Solutions of North Texas is a 501c3 operating in Denton since 2006 that specializes in addiction and alcoholism treatment regardless of ability to pay. More than 500 clients found recovery with supervised stays of 90 days. Solutions qualifies for discounts at Nebraska Furniture Mart such that an entire living room set can be acquired for \$1500. Denton Rotary Club proposes to fund the furniture purchase and organize a service event in January around putting it all together at Jerry's House, the operation center for Solutions of North Texas.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 50

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Wear and tear have taken their toll on the furniture there. One of the Solutions apartments, Jerry's House, needs a sofa, a love seat, an area rug, end tables, a coffee table, and a small entertainment center. Denton Rotary Club funded the furniture purchase and organize a service event in January around putting it all together at Jerry's House, with a plaque acknowledging Rotary's role.

Solutions of North Texas helps 700 people each year achieve recovery and stabilize their lives through both outpatient and residential programs. Solutions operates three sober living residences and our \$1,500 will improve the living conditions in the residences.

Solutions of North Texas purchased the furniture and allowed the Rotary Club to uncrate and install it in the residence named, Jerry's House.
