## **Project Description**

 Briefly describe the project outcomes. What was done (in 100 words or less)? 3,231 Dictionaries were presented to third graders in the Gilbert and Mesa School Districts, and San Tan Charter School.

When (dates) and where (city, state and country) did project activities take place?

Dictionaries and stickers were ordered after grant approval August 22,2022. Stickers were applied to the books between September 21-25, 2022. Deliveries were made between September 21-Nov 4, 2022. All activities occurred in Gilbert and Mesa, Arizona, USA.

Who were the beneficiaries? 3,231 third grade students in Gilbert and Mesa, Arizona, and their teachers.

- 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 13
- 3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Obtained from schools the census data, coordinated deliveries to the schools, applied stickers to the books (Four Way Test/Name tag, and Rotary Logo sticker), presented to some of the classes where time permitted.
- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? All of the students and all of the teachers were non-Rotarians, so approximately 3,250 individuals.
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? As third graders move from "learning to read" to "reading to learn," they encounter many new words. Dictionaries give them access to the correct spelling, pronunciation and meaning of 10,000 words, plus information about the Periodic Table, sign language, geography, astronomy, American history and the water table. Dictionaries may also used in merit testing of student achievement, if available to the student.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Gilbert and Mesa Public Schools and the San Tan Charter School provided census information and access to the students for presentations.
