Heart Mountain Interpretive Center

The Rotary Club of Cody and the Heart Mountain Interpretive Center (HMIC) are seeking \$35,000 added support for a sustainable cultural peace and conflict project to assist in developing the education of local high school, and statewide post-secondary, teachers and students. These individuals would team with the HMIC and the Cody Rotarians to help educate others, nationally and internationally, through physical site improvements and through website and virtual tour development. This sustainable project will impact individuals across the world by highlighting the lessons of the Japanese American confinement during World War II and its relevance to the preservation of liberty for all Americans.

Proposed Outcomes:

Effective secondary and post secondary curriculum will be established and will be available to schools within and outside Wyoming.

Educational signage will be in place to preserve and communicate the historical significance of the Heart Mountain Relocation Camp

Communities and individuals will be educated on a broader scale, nationally and globally, about civil and social injustices that occurred during World War II to the Japanese Americans and their Issei generation through educational kiosks, web resources and virtual tours.

Outcome Measures:
